

Twitter Deal Should go Ahead if it Provides Proof of Real Accounts: Musk

Elon Musk said that if Twitter Inc. could provide its method of sampling 100 accounts and how it confirmed that the accounts are real, his \$4.4 billion deal to buy the company should proceed on its original terms.

"However, if it turns out that their SEC filings are materially false, then it should not," Musk tweeted early on Saturday.

In response to a Twitter user asking whether the U.S. SEC is probing "dubious claims" by the company, Musk tweeted "Good question, why aren't they?"

"Twitter on Thursday dismissed Musk's claim that he was hoodwinked into signing the deal by the social media company, saying that it was 'implausible and contrary to fact'."

China Cuts Off Vital US Contacts over Pelosi Taiwan Visit

WASHINGTON: China cut off contacts with the United States on vital issues Friday - including military matters and crucial climate cooperation - as concerns rose that the Communist government's hostile reaction to House Speaker Nancy Pelosi's Taiwan visit would signal a lasting, more aggressive approach toward its US rival and the self-ruled island.

China's move to freeze key lines of communication compounded the worsening of relations from Pelosi's visit and from the Chinese response with military exercises of Taiwan, including firing missiles that splashed down in surrounding waters.

White House spokesman John Kirby condemned the decision to end important dialogue with the US as "irresponsible".

After the White House summoned China's ambassador, Qin Gang, late Tuesday to protest the military exercises.

'Sri Lanka's Hard Times Would Last Another Year'

Colombo: President Ranil Wickremesinghe has said that Sri Lanka's economic woes would last for another year and it will have to seek new sectors like logistics and nuclear energy to revive the bankrupt economy.

"Let's reset Sri Lanka" held on Friday, Wickremesinghe said that reforms in the country also would need higher taxation.

Rockets Fired from Gaza After Israeli Kill Militant

TEL AVIV: Hours after Israeli airstrikes killed several people including a leader of militant organization Palestinian Islamic Jihad (PIJ) in the Gaza Strip, several rockets were fired back at Israel from Gaza, according to media reports.

Air raid sirens were sounded in several Israeli cities, but the rockets went down in open terrain or were intercepted by the Iron Dome missile defence system, dpa news agency reported, citing the Israeli military.

The PJI's military arm said on Friday evening that the rockets were fired in retaliation for the killing of PJI commander Taysir al-Jabari. "We're attacking Tel Aviv and the cities of Israel," the statement said. "We're firing rockets with more than 100 missiles," it said.

Earlier, the Israeli military attacked several targets in the Gaza Strip following threats by the PJI. According to Palestinian sources, at least 16 people were killed in the Israeli attacks.
