Delhi cops' plea accepted, boy (17) will be tried as adult for murder

New Delhi: The Juvenile Justice Board has agreed to Delhi Police's request to try a delinquent 17-year-old boy in January reports. On January 26, Sarfraz Singh was murdered allegedly by three juveniles. The police apprehended the trio a few days later. An inquiry revealed they had fired two rounds from a pistol and stabbed Singh.

During the investigation, the police found out that on the day of the murder, one of the juveniles was approximately 17 years old. The additional public prosecutor for the state has submitted the juvenile committed the offence after planning and after deliberation and without provocation.
